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**DUI / Drivers License Checkpoint Nets 4 Arrests**

The Cypress Police Department conducted a DUI/Drivers License Checkpoint on May 1, 2010, as part of the City of Cypress' commitment to public safety. This checkpoint was one of many that have been and will be conducted throughout the year in the City of Cypress. The location of Saturday's checkpoint was on Lincoln Avenue west of Sumner. The goal of the checkpoint was to remove impaired drivers from the roadway and to bring awareness to the public of the dangers of driving under the influence of drugs and alcohol.

The location was chosen due to an increased number of DUI-related traffic collisions along Lincoln Avenue. The results of the checkpoint are as follows:

878 Vehicles screened  
44 Drivers screen for license or DUI violations  
3 DUI suspects arrested (2 of the suspects arrested for DUI were also unlicensed drivers)  
1 Driver arrested for a warrant  
9 Unlicensed driver arrests  
2 Suspended driver arrests  
17 Citations issued  
11 Vehicles towed  
9 Vehicles Impounded for 30 days

The checkpoint was funded by a grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety, through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration. Report Drunk Drivers – Call 9-1-1!
